This is second bail application filed by the petitioner for grant of concession of regular bail in criminal case arising from FIR No.390 dated 03.11.2018 registered under Sections 395, 397 and 412 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Sector-36, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no doubt the petitioner is an accused in three other cases but the first informants/victims in those cases have not supported the case of the prosecution.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that first informant in FIR No.390 has submitted that prosecution has already recorded evidence of 5 witnesses out of total 16 witnesses proposed to be examined.

Keeping in view the facts of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner. However, learned trial Court is requested to make a sincere endeavour and conclude the trial of the case within a period of four months.

Disposed of, accordingly.
