AMIT RAWAL, J. (Oral)

The present revision petition is directed against the dismissal of the objections filed against the ejectment order simply on the ground that the Regular Second Appeal with regard to the tile of the respondent-plaintiff is pending adjudication. The trial Court, after adjudication of the issue, noticed that the defendant is not permitted to deny the title owing to pendency of the appeal.

When this Court was about to dismiss the revision petition, Mr. Surinder Mohan Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from his client who is present in Court, submits that warrants of possession have already been issued and seeks time to vacate the premises. This Court put a condition for withdrawal only in case the petitioner would furnish undertaking not to file any further application objecting to the execution petition. Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner would not file any application. In such circumstances, I permit the learned counsel for the

petitioner to withdraw the present revision petition.
