The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.163 dated 29.6.2016 at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, District Ambala under Section 174-A of Indian Penal Code.

Vide order dated 21.12.2018, while issuing notice of motion, the petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court and trial Court had been directed to release the petitioner on interim bail.

The learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kulvir Singh, has informed that the petitioner has indeed appeared before the trial Court pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court.

In view of the aforesaid position and bearing in mind the nature of offence and that the petitioner has already caused appearance
