These petitions under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure have been filed for issuance of directions to the learned trial Court to abide by the statutory provisions of Section 143(3) of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (in short 'the Act') with regard to Criminal Complaint No.104/2017 dated 24.4.2017, titled M/s Gill Trading Company and another v. M/s Surya Industries and others, and Criminal Complaint No. 129/2017 dated 11.5.2017 titled M/s Burj Trading Company and another v. M/s Surya Industries and others, both filed under Section 138 of the Act and are pending before the learned SDJM, Patti.

A perusal of the files show that the trial Court is rightly proceeding with the complaints. The Court is not lacking in any aspect in this regard.

Therefore, this Court does not find any ground to issue any directions qua time

bound disposal of the complaints.

However, the record also shows that the accused might be adopting the delaying tactics. Therefore, the present petitions are disposed of with the observations that the trial Court shall ensure that the trial is not delayed any more because of any frivolous or unnecessary applications moved by the accused.
