Learned State counsel, on instructions from the police official who is present in Court to assist him, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation pursuant to the order dated 19.11.2019 and presently his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, the interim order dated 19.11.2019, passed by this Court, is made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.

However, this order will not be treated to be an observation of this court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require custodial interrogation of the petitioner.

Naturally, the complainant would be at liberty to avail of his remedy as legally available, as regards any grievance, including the investigation process.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
