Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No. 167 dated 28.7.2013, under Sections 302, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, (Sections 150 and 120-B IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kapurthala City, District Kapurthala.
