This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.463 dated 28.06.2017 registered under Sections 148/149/325/506 (302 added later on) at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

The ground taken is that no direct allegation was levelled against the petitioner in the FIR and even after the deposition of the injured-complainant no injury has been attributed to the present petitioner and the case of the present petitioner is of parity with that of Rakesh, who has been granted bail by this Court in CRM-M-21996-2018 on 27.11.2018.

Learned Assistant Advocate General on instructions from ASI Anil Kumar has accepted these factual assertions.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
