ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 7, dated 10.1.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Barwala, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he has caused *gandasi* blow on the right ear of the complainant. He further contends that the injured has recovered from this injury and the petitioner, who is 19 years of age, is in custody for over 14 months since his arrest on 2.2.2018. He also states that all other co-accused have been granted bail.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Randhir, states that the petitioner is also involved in another case bearing FIR No.16 of 2015, under Sections 323, 341, 506 and 34 IPC. He, however, is not in a position to state that the petitioner is in custody for over a year and is of 19 years of age.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is 19 years of age, he is in custody for over a year and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it appropriate to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner, namely, Monu is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
