Counsel for respondents No.1 to 5/State states that they are proforma respondents and their reply on merits is not needed.

In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the resolution which has been passed by the Co-operative Society i.e. respondent No.4 dated 16.06.2018 (Annexure P-4). Counsel for the respondents states that no writ petition lies against the cooperative society and the petitioner has to first exhaust his remedy under the Cooperative Society Act, 1961 for the redressal of his grievances.
