As per pleadings on record, petitioner was appointed as Family Welfare Field Worker with the Red Cross Family Welfare Centre, Jalandhar in the year 2003. Counsel submits that the petitioner has worked continuously since the date of appointment and has discharged his duties and responsibilities to the satisfaction of his superiors.

Instant petition has been filed raising a grievance that the petitioner has not been released his salary since the year 2008.

It is submitted that the District Red Cross Society, Jalandhar is running an Urban Family Welfare Centre towards promotion of a National Program and which is 100% aided and the salary of the staff of the Family Welfare Centre is paid out of the Grant-in-Aid released by the Director, Health Services and Family Welfare, Punjab.

Counsel submits that he would be satisfied, if, at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent authorities to look into the claim of the petitioner and to take a final decision thereupon expeditiously.

Prayer made by counsel is just and reasonable.

As such, without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to respondents no.2 and 3 to examine the grievance of the petitioner in the light of a legal notice dated 29.10.2018 (Annexure P-4) i.e. already stated to have been served. Claim of the petitioner be decided strictly in accordance with law and within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
