ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.13 dated 21.01.2015, under Sections 458, 324, 323, 436 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been attributed a 'kirpan' blow on the hand of the complainant. The complainant has fully recovered from the injuries and the matter has also been compromised. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for almost 3 months.

Learned counsel for the complainant has put in appearance and states that the matter has indeed been compromised.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Baldev Singh, states that the investigation has been completed and the police is in the process of filing the challan.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when petitioner is in custody for about 3 months, matter has been compromised and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
