In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the grade pay, which was extended to the petitioner on the post of Technical Assistant, was not correct. Counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was extended the grade pay of Rs.3300/-, whereas, after promotion on the post of Technical Assistant, he was entitled for grade pay of Rs.4000/-, which was never extended to him. He further relies on letter written by the Deputy Director, Insensitive Live Stock Development Project and Dairying, Gurugram dated 01.10.2009/30.09.2009 (Annexure P/3) to support his claim for grade pay of Rs.4000/-.

The present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner in the year 2019 claiming the relief, which relates to the year 2008, when the petitioner was working on the post of Technical Assistant, from which post he already retired in the year 2008. The delay has not been explained, as to why, the petitioner has filed the present writ petition after a period of eleven years of his retirement.

Counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which is being claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted representation dated 26.08.2019 (Annexure P/6) to the respondents, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondent No.2. is directed to decide the representation dated 26.08.2019 (Annexure P/6) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. It is made clear that in case, the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the arrears will be paid only from the date of representation dated 26.08.2019 (Annexure P/6).

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
