By way of present petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to offer him appointment to a Class-IV post on compassionate grounds on account of death of his father. In the circumstances, petitioner also submitted representation dated 16.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) to the respondents.

2. The petitioner also caused issuance of a legal notice dated 18.07.2019 (Annexure P-3), but the same has not been adverted to till date by the respondents. Hence this petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 18.07.2019 (Annexure P-3) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
