This order shall dispose of above mentioned two petitions.

These petitions have been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for

grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case F.I.R. No.420 dated 25.06.2018 registered under Sections 307/34/120-B IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar Bhiwani.

Custody certificates dated 12.02.2019 filed by way of affidavit of Ram Niwas, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison (Bhiwani), Haryana on behalf of State are taken on record. Copies supplied to the counsel opposite.

The allegations against the present petitioner/s are firstly that the petitioner-Virender had informed the main accused about the location of the injured persons and the allegations against the petitioner-Mandeep was that he was riding a motor cycle on which the main accused had come.

Counsel for the petitioner/s has argued that the petitioners have been in custody for more than 6 months.

As per custody certificates, the period of custody of both the petitioner/s is verified. However, counsel for the complainant and Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Rohtash states that in this case the prosecution evidence is fixed for 21.02.2019, and on that date, the complainant and the injured would give their statements and till then the bail should not be granted.

I find this to be a fair request. Complainant and the injured is directed to give their statements on 21.02.2019 and the trial Court is further directed to grant bail to these two petitioners on 22.02.2019.

Ordered accordingly.

Petitions stand disposed of.

Since the main cases have been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
