On 29.11.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail
in criminal case arising from FIR No.134 dated
16.10.2019 registered under Sections
324/452/323/326/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code and
25 of Arms Act at Police Station Majitha Road, Amritsar,
District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

As per case of the prosecution, Mehakdeep
Singh was attacked by the accused and other persons
when he was admitted in the Hospital. Petitioner No.1 is
alleged to have inflicted two injuries with his *daatar*
below the knee of the left leg.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends
that petitioners have been falsely implicated as brother of

petitioner No.1 had suffered a gun shot injury when the first informant party had attacked. Sahib Singh was admitted in Hospital on 10.10.2019 at 07:54 PM whereas incident taken place at 3:00 PM. FIR was registered on the statement of Sahib Singh at Police Station Mehta.

Notice of motion for 16.12.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Davinderjit Singh has submitted that petitioners have joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 29.11.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
