Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.112 dated 16.06.2007 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station “B” Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the case against the petitioner is false and got lodged due to misunderstanding between the petitioner and the complainant. After full-fledged trial, the other co-accused of the petitioner have already been acquitted by the trial Court. The complainant has even settled the matter with the petitioner by way of compromise. The petitioner is in custody since 12.11.2018. No purpose would be served by keeping him in custody.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that before arrest, the petitioner was proclaimed offender for about five years. However, it is not disputed that the co-accused of the petitioner have been acquitted.

In view the above, but without expressing any further opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
