In response to notice of motion issued by this Court, reply by way of affidavit of Gursheer Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Circle Amloh, District Fatehgarh Sahib has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Perusal of Paragraph-3 of the said reply reveals that proceedings under Section 107/150 of Cr. P.C. have already been initiated against private-respondents on 06.02.2019 vide DDR No.34 of 06.02.2019. Further transpires that petitioner has been verbally informed that in case of any grievance, she can inform the office of DSP, Amloh or Police Station Mandi Gobindgarh and necessary action will be taken against erring person(s).

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in this case.

Petition stands disposed off. However, it is clarified that in case petitioner still feels aggrieved, she can take recourse to the remedy available under law.
