In pursuance to the order of this Court dated 27.02.2019, compliance report by way of short affidavit of the respondent alongwith speaking order dated 05.03.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. The operative part of the speaking order is as under:-

“In compliance of the above said order of the Hon'ble High Court, the matter was got enquired into through the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur. The Inquiry Officer submitted his report that there is no threat to the petitioner and her family members from the private respondents No.6 to 12 mentioned in CRM-M No.30608 of 2017. However, the directions have been issued to Halqa Officer and SHO, Police Station, Ghuman Kalan to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members.

It is also directed that the directions have been issued to SHO, Police Station, Ghuman Kalan to provide the security to the petitioner for appearing before the trial Court at Gurdaspur on the date fixed i.e. 08.03.2019.

The directions passed by the Hon'ble High Court have been complied with, in its true letter and spirit.”

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
