1. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was appointed as Computer Engineer (Visiting Faculty) on hourly basis @ ₹400/- per hour (maximum ₹25,000/- per month) at Govt. Polytechnic, Lisana, pursuant to advertisement Annexure P/1 and has been continuing as such ever since till 27.08.2019. However, despite availability of work load, work is not being taken from the petitioner. Learned counsel contends that despite the petitioner having submitted representation Annexure P/6 13.09.2019, for being allowed to work on hourly basis in terms of his selection, no decision has been taken on the representation till date and that in the circumstances the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in representation Annexure P/6 dated 13.09.2019 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

2. Learned Sr. DAG states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Without commenting on the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner for appointment as Computer Engineer (Visiting Faculty) on hourly basis, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in representation Annexure P/6 dated 13.09.2019, in accordance with law, within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
