The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.p.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.188 dated 16.08.2018, registered under Section 376-AB of IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

It is the case of the prosecution that on 15.08.2018, at about 5:30/6:00 p.m. the minor child aged about 07 years was playing near the house of the petitioner. When the petitioner found her alone he picked up her and took her into his shop. Then he insert finger in her private part. The petitioner also put off his *Pajama* and touched her private part.

Heard. In the instant case, the trial is in progress. The prosecutrix as well as her mother has already been examined.

After going through the record, this court is of the opinion that no case is made to grant the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner.

As such, finding no merit in the instant petition the same is dismissed. However, the trial court is directed to expedite the trial and dispose of the same preferably with four months.
