Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.52 dated 14.05.2019 under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 326 & 201 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Moonak, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the petitioner is attributed an injury on the left arm of the complainant, which was declared to be grievous and Section 326 IPC was added later on. It is further submitted that even from the petitioner's side, in an earlier incident, one Aman Singh sustained serious injuries at the hands of complainant's side and lost his vision. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and is in custody since 11.10.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjit, has not disputed the fact that the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the left arm of

the complainant, which was declared grievous, however, it is submitted that the complainant has suffered total 07 injuries and other injuries are declared simple in nature.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering the fact that the petitioner is first offender; he is not involved in any other case and is in custody for the last two months, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
