The claimant failed to lead evidence before the Labour Court despite last opportunity. He did not step into the witness-box to support his version in the demand notice. His evidence was closed by court order. It was a case of no evidence. Besides, an award passed on 02.04.2010 is sought to be challenged in this petition filed in the year 2018. Consequently, this petition deserves dismissal for the reason of inordinate delay and laches. The petition raises a ‘dead’ and ‘stale’ claim and is ordered to stand dismissed.
