This is an application for re-calling order dated 20.9.2019 vide which the contempt petition was dismissed for non-prosecution.

Mr. Sandeep S. Mann, Senior DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court accepts notice. He has no objection to the acceptance of the prayer of the applicants/petitioners.

CM is allowed. The contempt petition is restored to its original number.

COCP No. 86 of 2019

Learned counsel for the State submits that in compliance to the

directions of this Court passed on 20.12.2017, orders have been passed with regard to petitioners No. 7 to 10, rejecting their claim. The claim of petitioners No. 1 to 6 has been accepted, the benefits already granted and in case not paid the same would be paid within six weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law with regard to the rejection of claim of petitioners No. 7 to 10.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
