On 20.11.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR No.13 dated 30.1.2019 registered under Sections 307, 324, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, District Jalandhar.

Apart from other submissions, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that settlement has been arrived at between the two rival groups vide Annexure P-3. He further relies upon an order dated 15.11.2019 passed by learned Court of Sessions while dealing with the bail application of Gurpreet Singh @ Gopi wherein it has been noticed that parties have entered into a settlement and injured appeared before the Court of Sessions and admitted the factum of settlement.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. AG, Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab and prays for time to seek instructions.

Let a copy of the petition be supplied to the learned counsel for the State during the course of the day.

Adjourned to 9.12.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Prem Lal has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, order dated 20.11.2019 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
