The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking direction to the respondents to grant higher emoluments in the higher pay scale of the post of Junior Engineer (Civil) for the period he worked on the said post. Consequential benefits/arrears alongwith interest were also prayed for. The writ petition was disposed of on 28.9.2018 directing the Chief Engineer (Head Quarter), Punjab, Mini Secretariat PWD, B&R, Patiala, to decide the legal notice dated 10.8.2017. The needful was to be done within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

The present petition has been filed pleading that there is non-compliance of directions of this Court.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Satish Kumar Gupta, Chief Engineer (Headquarters) Punjab, PWD (B&R), Mini Secretariat, Patiala. Alongwith affidavit an order dated 12.12.2019 is annexed, the same is taken on record and copy supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instruction from Mr. Rajinder Singh, (Senior Assistant) O/o Chief Engineer, PWD, B&R, Patiala, submits that the claim of the petitioner has been accepted and monetary benefits would be credited to the account of the petitioner and details of amount found due would be communicated within eight weeks from today.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance if any.
