Petitioner Sukhwinder Singh @ Shanky has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.10 dated 21.01.2015, registered at Police Station C-Division, Amritsar, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the allegation as per the FIR against the present petitioner is that he had taken ₹1.20 lakhs from the complainant for arranging job for his younger brother.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the petitioner has brought to the notice of this Court that the parties have already effected the compromise and the quashing petition on the basis of

compromise has already been filed and is pending before this Court.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 21.12.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 21.12.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
