By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Though the petitioner is stated to be the main accused in the FIR, he having been in custody for more than 7 months, with only 2 prosecution witnesses out of 21 have been examined so far, with no other criminal case shown to be registered against him as per the learned State counsel (who says so on instructions from ASI Mann Singh, who is present in court to assist him), without making any comment on the merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, this petition is allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
