Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.97, dated 26.06.2019, registered under Sections 397/201 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Garhi, District Jind.

As per the case of the prosecution, first informant, a truck driver, had lodged this complaint with the averments that his vehicle was stopped and 2 persons entered his vehicle and while giving threat by displaying firearm, snatched purse, registration papers of the vehicle and mobile phone.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been nominated as an accused on the statement of a co-accused.

On conclusion of the investigation, police report has been submitted and even charges have been framed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 07.07.2019 and the hearing of the case is likely to take long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
