GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case registered vide FIR No.230 dated 18.09.2018 under Sections 397, 341 & 395 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, Police Station Cheeka, District Kaithal.
2. The FIR was registered at the instance of Krishan Kumar, who has stated that on 18.09.2018 when he along with his brother Surinder Singh was going from Cheeka to Syosar in Verna vehicle bearing registration No.HR41-G-6404, then a Swift vehicle came from behind,

in which 5 persons were sitting and stopped their vehicle and two persons armed with guns came out of the vehicle and snatched their Verna car at gun point from his brother who was driving the vehicle.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he has falsely been implicated in the present case and in any case since challan has already been presented, no useful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioner behind bars.
4. Learned State counsel while opposing the petition has submitted that in view of the serious nature of allegations, no case for grant of bail is made out.
5. Having considered rival contentions addressed before this Court and bearing in mind that challan has already been presented and that the petitioner has been behind bars since last about 3 months and 15 days and that conclusion of trial, in its normal course, is likely to take some time, in my opinion, no fruitful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioner behind bars. Accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
6. This petition stands accepted accordingly.
