Petitioner seeks issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect her life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.6 and 7.

Counsel has been heard at length.

Pleadings on record are wholly insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Rather pleadings on record would suggest that there is a dispute inter se the parties pertaining to certain premises in which the petitioner is a tenant. Even civil litigation pertaining to the same very tenanted premises stands initiated.

In an overview of the matter, no interference in the matter is warranted.

Petition dismissed.
