It is contended that although the petitioner/plaintiff manage to examine the other witnesses but evidence of District Kanoongo, Gurdaspur, could not be led as the District Kanoongo did not appear in spite of depositing the diet money etc. by the plaintiff and serving the summons upon him. The trial Court closed the evidence in view of the order passed by this Court granting last opportunity. It is further stated that the petitioner will be prejudiced, in case he is not able to examine the official witness.

Accordingly, the order 06.11.2019 passed by the trial Court is set aside with liberty to the petitioner to examine the concerned official witness. The trial Court shall take necessary steps in accordance with law for examination of District Kanoongo, Gurdaspur.

Disposed of in the above terms.
