The present revision petition is filed with a prayer to set aside the order dated 04.10.2017, passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Moga (for short, the trial Court), vide which, the petitioner/plaintiff was restrained from producing the original document i.e. compromise in his evidence in view of his refusal to produce the original compromise on the ground that he does not possess it.

This Court does not find any error or ambiguity in the said order. Accordingly, there being no merit in the prayer to set aside the said order, the same is declined.

However, it is stated in para 8 of the grounds of revision petition that the plaintiff/petitioner was having a copy of the said compromise, which he wanted to produce as additional evidence but the application for additional evidence has not been entertained in view of order dated 04.10.2017. It is apparent that the said order pertains to the original

compromise and not to a copy of the compromise. Accordingly, the trial Court is directed to entertain the application and decide the same, in accordance with law.

Disposed of in the above terms.
