Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Birender Singh, Engineer-in-Chief, Irrigation and Water Resources Department, Haryana, filed today in Court, is taken on record and copy supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that albeit the order dated 4.12.2019 is passed but some amount is still due. It is contended that the amount found due, till date is not credited to the account of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instruction from Mr. Sumit, SDO, Project Sub Div. No.1, Panchkula, O/o EIC Irrigation and W.R. Department, Panchkula submits that the amount found payable would be credited to the account of the petitioner within three weeks from today.

The respondents are directed to provide details of calculation of amount found due to the petitioner within three weeks from today.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case the grievance still survives.

In case the statement made today in Court is not adhered to, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition and in case the petitioner is forced to do so, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable personally from the defaulting officer/official.
