[1] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file a comprehensive representation in respect of the relief prayed for in the instant writ petition with a direction to the respondent to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[2] In view of the innocuous nature of prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation to the respondent. In case of receipt of representation, respondent would consider and decide the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with the representation.
