The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 12.12.2015.

As per the undertaking, the respondents were required to vacate the premises by 30.06.2018. It is not disputed that the same have since been vacated by way of an execution on 23.08.2018.

In view of the above, no useful purpose would be served in continuing with the present contempt petition. The same is dismissed accordingly.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, in case, the petitioner is still aggrieved with the non-payment of any arrears or main profits, he is at liberty to seek execution of the same as well.
