Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of pre arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.168 dated 02.11.2018, under Section 365 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural.

While issuing notice of motion, this court passed the following order on 26.12.2018:-

“Contends that daughter of the complainant namely Harkaramjit Kaur, who was married with the petitioner in the year 2004, is alleged to have been missing since 16.03.2018 and the present FIR has been lodged on 02.11.2018. Further contends that initially the petitioner was granted the interim protection by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar and he joined the investigation and is still ready to join the same.

Notice of motion for 05.02.2019.

Mr. Umesh Aggarwal, Advocate appears on behalf of complainant and files vakalatnama, same is taken on record.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Arwinder Singh has acknowledged that in terms of the previous order the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 26.12.2018 is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
