[1] Claim of the petitioner is for promotion from the post of JBT to TGT, which is being denied on the ground that the petitioner has not qualified in the subject in B.Ed. for which promotion is sought to the post of TGT.

[2] Learned counsel contends that the matter in controversy is no longer *res integra* and stands settled by the decision of a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, attached along with as Annexure P-7 (colly.) but despite legal notice (Annexure P-6) dated 16.08.2019, no decision *qua* the claim made therein has been taken till date.

[3] Learned counsel contends that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage, by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice (Annexure P-6) dated 16.08.2019, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[4] Without commenting upon the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is ***disposed***

legal notice (Annexure P-6) dated 16.08.2019, in accordance with law and by taking into account the decisions relied upon in case the same are applicable as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
