The petitioner filed a writ petition for grant of revised pay scale after she was appointed as a Craft Teacher. The writ petition was disposed of on 17.12.2018. The relevant portion is quoted below:

"In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 29.05.2018 (Annexure P-26) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to her within a period of next three months.

Present writ petition stands disposed of."

The present petition is filed pleading that the needful is not done by the respondents.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Abhimanu Goyat submits that the monetary benefits have been credited to the account of the petitioner and the order to the said effect would be communicated within four weeks from today.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

The respondents concerned are directed to pass a speaking order and details of amount found due be also provided to the petitioner expeditiously. The petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance if any.
