[1] Learned counsel contends that prayer in the writ petition is for regularization of the petitioners with effect from the date persons juniors to them were regularized on 1.4.2011.

[2] Learned counsel contends that the petitioners were appointed as Class -IV on part time basis on different dates during the period 1994-2001 and on the basis of instructions applicable were ordered to be regularized vide order dated 25.08.2014 whereas subsequently vide order Annexure P-4 dated 18.07.2017 persons appointed as Class -IV employees later than the petitioners were regularized w.e.f. 1.4.2011 i.e. a date prior to the date of regularization of the services of the petitioners.

[3] Learned counsel contends that the petitioners have served legal notice, Annexure P-5 dated 25.04.2019 to the respondents in respect of the grievance which is the subject matter of the instant writ petition but the claim made in the legal notice has not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied if at this stage the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide

the claim made in the legal notice, Annexure P-5 dated 25.04.2019 in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.

[4] Without commenting upon the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the claim as made in legal notice, Annexure P-5 dated 25.04.2019 in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order along with copy of legal notice.
