The petitioners are the parents, brothers and sisters-in-law of respondent No.6. The wife of respondent No.6, namely, Ramandeep Kaur (respondent No.5) has submitted a complaint dated 28.9.2018 (P1) against the petitioners and respondent No.6 in the Women Cell, Jalandhar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the aforementioned complaint, the petitioners were called for enquiry and ultimately, they were found innocent by the Incharge, Women Cell, Jalandhar (Rural). Yet, the petitioners are being called for further enquiry by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, namely, Sh. Gurmeet Singh Kingra, for no valid reasons. Thus, a direction may be issued to the police officials not to call the petitioners for repeated enquiries.
