The petitioner filed a writ petition claiming parity with one Bhim Singh being senior to him in all cadre during his service career. The petition was disposed of on 21.1.2019 directing the respondent to decide the legal notice dated 16.9.2018. The needful was to be done within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. It was further ordered that in case the petitioner is found entitled to monetary benefits, the same should be released to him within next three months.

The present petition is filed pleading that needful has not been done.

Separate replies by way of affidavit of Mr. Vishal Bansal, IA &AS, Principal Accountant General (A&E), Haryana, Chandigarh, and Mr.Ashwani Phougat, Executive Engineer, Rai Water Resources Division, Sonipat, filed today in Court, are taken on record and copies supplied to

counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel relying upon order dated 21.11.2019 annexed with the reply states that the claim of the petitioner has been accepted. He further on instruction from Mr. Ankit, SDO, O/o Irrigation Department, Haryana, submits that in case any monetary benefits accrue, the same would be calculated and credited to his account within six weeks from today. The authority shall also supply to the petitioner the details of amount found due.

In view of above the contempt petition is disposed of.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law in case the grievance still survives.

In case the statement made today in Court is not adhered to, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition and in case the petitioner is forced to do so, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable personally from the defaulting officer/official.
