The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 292 dated 28.10.2019, under Sections 384 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station City Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and she has been falsely implicated, as she is the wife of Rashpal Singh, who is alleged to have tried to extort money from the complainant along with co-accused, namely, Gurdarshan Singh. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 27.11.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Rajbir Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 27.11.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
