Grievance of the petitioner is against the action taken by the respondent in withholding his appointment and joining on the post of Revenue Patwari despite the fact that he has been selected on merit basis after qualifying the written test, counselling and requisite training from the Government Patwar Training School, Hoshiarpur. The petitioner also caused legal notice dated 04.08.2019 (Annexure P-19). Hence the petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of respondent-State.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 04.08.2019 (Annexure P-19) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
