The petitioner filed a writ petition raising a grievance that her height was wrongly recorded while she competed for post of Constable in Cadre of Punjab Police (Female) in the category of BC.

The writ petition was disposed of on 6.9.2019 directing the respondent to re-measure the height of the petitioner by constituting an appropriate Committee.

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that needful has not been done.

Learned counsel for respondents has produced order dated 22.11.2019, the same is taken on record and copy supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that in an inter-related matter, State has preferred an intra-court appeal in which there is status-quo with regard to measurement of height and hence, the direction of this Court cannot

be complied with at this stage.

Learned counsel for petitioner is not in a position to dispute the said factual position.

The contempt petition is disposed of at this stage with liberty to revive the same in case cause of action so survives after decision of LPA or in case the order passed in appeal is modified.
