Petitioner prays for bail pending trial in FIR No.309 dated 29.11.2018 registered under Sections 21, 25, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

As per case of the prosecution which was registered on the basis of secret information, petitioner alongwith his co-accused were seen coming with 500 grams of heroin. Petitioner was successful in escaping whereas co-accused of the petitioner was arrested with 500 grams of heroin.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Mehal Singh, has submitted that the petitioner is a habitual offender, involved in two more cases under the NDPS Act.

In view thereof, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody, learned Special Court is requested to expedite the conclusion of the trial.

Disposed of, accordingly.
