This order shall dispose of COCP Nos. 3944, 3952, 3955, 3956, 3957, 3962 and 3963 of 2019, as the issue involved in all the petitions is identical.

A bunch of writ petitions was disposed of by this Court on 26.2.2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Under the circumstances, the bunch of petitions are hereby disposed of with a direction that a committee of three officers headed by Chief Secretary shall be constituted to consider the claim of the petitioners as well as related issues. A decision shall be taken within two months and the petitioners be informed accordingly. The committee would also take into consideration the consolidated affidavit filed in CWP No. 24341 and 29601

of 2017 while arriving at its decision.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage considering the fact that the Court has already taken cognizance of the disobedience of the aforesaid directions and the matters are pending for 17.12.2019. He seeks liberty to address the issue in the said cases. He also seeks liberty to file fresh one in case cause of action still survives after the decision of those cases.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage with liberty as prayed for.
