After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to file a comprehensive representation for grant of relief as is prayed for in the writ petition and direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation on receipt of the same in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

Without commenting on the merits of the claim and in view of the innocuous nature of the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the writ petition is permitted to be withdrawn while granting liberty to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation to respondent No.2 within two weeks from today. On receipt of the representation, respondent No.2 would consider and decide the same in accordance with law within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
