Grievance of the petitioner is that she has not been granted revised pay-scale (Lecturer in English) equal to the basic pay-scale of Lecturers in English working in the Government Polytechnics under the same department in terms of the decision taken by Government dated 21.12.2011 (Annexure P-8) and in view of the recommendations of the department vide memo dated 26.09.2016 (Annexure P-14). Further prayer has been made for grant of pay-scale of Rs.15600-39110+Rs.5400/- Grade Pay to the solitary post of English Lecturer in the respondent No.4 institute, from the date of her regular appointment vide memo dated 22.12.2011 (Annexure P-7).

2. The petitioner submitted representation dated 04.10.2018 (Annexure P-16), but the same has not been adverted to till date by the respondents. Hence the writ petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 04.10.2018 (Annexure P-16) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law. It would be appreciated if the judgment rendered by this Court contained at annexure P-18 is gone through before passing speaking order and reasons be given as to why benefit of ratio rendered therein, be not accorded to the petitioner.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. Disposed of in above terms.
