By way of instant petition, the petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize his services against regular post in regular grade as per Punjab Government Instructions dated 04.03.1999 and 23.01.2001 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and also in view of the judgments contained at Annexures P-3, P-4 and P-5 respectively.

2. The petitioner also caused legal notice dated 29.09.2019 (Annexure P-6), but the same has not been adverted to till date by the respondents. Hence the petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of copy of petition, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab has put in appearance

on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 29.09.2019 (Annexure P-6) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

8. Disposed of in above terms.
