On 22.11.2019, while noticing the contention of learned
counsel for the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that
the petitioner is a mere labourer and had nothing to do
with the alleged illegal mining.*

*Let a copy of the petition be handed over to Mr.
Hittan Nehra, Additional Advocate General, Punjab,
learned counsel for the State, who is requested to get
complete information and assist.*

Adjourned to 26.11.2019.”

In this case, prosecution alleges illegal sand mining by the

petitioner alongwith his co-accused.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Baldev Singh, has submitted that petitioner is not a labourer but is actively involved in illegal mining.

In view thereof, there is no ground to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
